

ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SECTION 2.20.020, UPTON MUNICIPAL CODE, TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF UPTON FROM SEVEN MEMBERS TO FIVE MEMBERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF UPTON, WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING

1. Section 2.20.020 of the Upton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.20.020 Membership. The planning commission shall be composed of five members appointed by the mayor with the approval of the town council. The terms of the members appointed to the first planning commission shall be arranged so that the terms of three members shall expire at the end of the second year, and two at the end of the third year. Thereafter, each member shall be appointed for a term of three years. In the event of a vacancy in the commission, the mayor shall fill the vacancy, with approval of the council, by appointment for the unexpired term. Commission members may be removed from the commission, for cause other than politics or religion, after public hearing by the city council.
