

ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES 2016

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN ADDITIONAL SECTION ON ABATEMENT OF JUNK VEHICLE(S) TO CHAPTER 8.16 OF THE UPTON MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF UPTON, WYOMING,

Section 1: A new Section 8.016.060 is hereby adopted to the Upton Municipal Code and shall read as follows:

The Town of Upton may abate nuisances and junk vehicle(s) considered nuisances under Section 8.016.010 by providing written notice to the owner of the vehicle, if known, and if not by placing a notice upon the windshield of the junk vehicle, of the Town of Upton's intent to remove the junk vehicle(s) from the individual's property on a certain date if the junk vehicle(s) is/are not removed or sheltered. The notice to the owner and the notice placed upon the vehicle, shall describe the Town of Upton's intended actions and the date and time of the intended action to remove and abate the junk vehicle(s) from the owner's property. If the owner fails to remove the junk vehicle(s) from a public right-of-way or from the owner's property or shelter, the Town may remove the junk vehicle(s) and charge the owner, if known, the cost of removal and shall call for payment of a storage fee of \$25.00 per day for each day the junk vehicle(s) remain(s) in the Town of Upton's possession. If the owner of the junk vehicle(s) does not remove the vehicle(s) as called for in the notice provided to the owner within thirty (30) days following notice, the Town of Upton may sell the vehicle pursuant to Wyoming law and apply the proceeds first to the costs of removal and then to the storage fee. Amounts paid by a third party purchaser over and above the cost of removal and storage shall be returned to the owner. If the proceeds from the sale of the junk vehicle do not cover the costs of removal and storage the Town may add the amount over and above the costs of removal and storage to the owner's utility bills. Failure to pay the total utility bill may thereafter result in disconnection of water and sewer services pending payment.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication.

Section 3: Any other ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
