

**PROCLAMATION
AGENT ORANGE HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH
AUGUST 2019**

WHEREAS, the health and safety of the citizens of Upton, Wyoming is important to the happiness, prosperity and well-being of our Town's families and community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Upton, Wyoming is the proud home of many veterans, including Vietnam Veterans, who bravely served their country; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of those who have been exposed to Agent Orange and as many as five future generations who may also suffer from a number of deleterious health effects associated with the toxic dioxin in Agent Orange; and

WHEREAS, in recognition that because more than nineteen million gallons of herbicide was sprayed throughout South Vietnam, with Agent Orange accounting for approximately eleven million gallons, causing the United States department of veteran's affairs to presume that all veterans who served in Vietnam were exposed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Upton, along with the Governor of the great state of Wyoming, recognizes the month of August 2019 as **AGENT ORANGE HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH** in our **TOWN OF UPTON, WYOMING**, and call this observance to the attention of all our citizens.
