

Town of Upton
Annual Appropriations for FY 19-20 Hearing
June 9, 2020

THE BUDGET HEARING of the Town Council of Upton, Wyoming was held at 6:45 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 at the Upton City Hall located at 725 2nd Street in Upton, Wyoming.

Present: Mayor Travis Beck, Council Members David Watt, Joe Watt, Justin Norman and Dennis Stirmel. Staff present included Attorney Mark Hughes, Clerk/Treasurer Kelley Millar, Superintendent Mark Lindstrom, Police Chief Susan Bridge and Fire Chief John Strong. Public attendance included *Weston County Gazette Assistant Editor* Nicholas Trandahl, Bearlodge Engineering owner Kenny Rathbun, and Rick Rothleutner.

Mayor Beck led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Beck opened the hearing at 6:45 p.m. and asked for public comment, comments from the Council and comments from staff. Clerk/Treasurer Millar offered information regarding Governor Gordon's most recent recommendations for budget reductions to state agencies and reiterated that the Town of Upton had already made an approximate reduction of 22% from the previous fiscal year and that she was comfortable with the numbers presented and published for the budget hearing.

There being no further comments or objections, Mayor Beck closed the hearing at 6:46 p.m.
