**A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG) FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2021 ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE TOWN OF UPTON, WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING**
