

**RESOLUTION NO. 7, 2026**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN CLAIMS AND EXPENDITURES BETWEEN REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF UPTON, WYOMING, SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION**

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Town of Upton recognizes that certain expenditures and claims arise in the ordinary course of municipal operations which require payment prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Governing Body; and

**WHEREAS**, utility billing operations, payroll obligations, debt service payments, grant-related expenditures, contractual obligations, emergency purchases, and other special circumstance expenditures may require timely payment in order to avoid penalties, service interruption, loss of discounts, operational disruption, or noncompliance with contractual or statutory requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to authorize the Clerk/Treasurer to process and issue payment for such claims and expenditures between regularly scheduled meetings when necessary for the continued and efficient operation of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body further desires that all such payments made between meetings be presented to the Governing Body for review and ratification at the next regular meeting;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF UPTON, WYOMING**, that the Clerk/Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue payment for utility bills and other special circumstance expenditures between regularly scheduled meetings of the Governing Body when such payments are necessary for the continued operation of the Town and when delay would not be in the best interest of the Town.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all such expenditures and claims paid between meetings shall be presented to the Governing Body at the next regular meeting for review and ratification and shall be included in the official claims list and meeting record.
